The Bonnechere Union Public Library exists as a cultural device in providing access to print and non-print materials and programs to fulfill the educational, informational, and recreational interests of the community.

MEMBERSHIP

- Bonnechere Valley & North Algona Wilberforce residents/taxpayers - Free
- Admaston Bromley residents/taxpayers - Free with AB library card
- Killaloe, Hagarty, & Richards residents/taxpayers - Free with KHR library card
- Non-residents (3 months) - \$15
- Non-residents (year) - \$40

Provide documentation with your current address, fill out a form, and your card will be issued immediately!

INTERLIBRARY LOANS

If we don't have a book you need, BUPL staff can order it in from another library! Fill out a form online or at the front desk. Books are usually available 8 months after they've been published. Unfortunately, audio-visual materials are not available through ILLO. Requests are limited to two books per patron.

LIBRARY MATERIALS

We have books, DVDs, magazines, newspapers, large print books, audiobooks, music CDs, video games, eBooks, audiobooks, graphic novels, French books, and family passes to museums. We also have snowshoes, a telescope, and a CNIB Daisy/Victor Reader.

LOAN PERIODS

- 3 weeks - Books, magazines, CDs, audio books
- 1 week - DVDs, video games
- 3 days - Snowshoes, museum passes
- 24 hrs - BUPLscope

OVERDUE FINES

- \$0.25/day per item - Books, magazines, CDs, large print books, audio books
- \$0.50/day per item - Museum passes
- \$1.00/day per item - DVDs, video games
- \$10.00/day - Telescope

RENEWALS, HOLDS & RESERVES

As long as no one has placed a hold on an item, materials can be renewed up to three times. If our library has an item you would like that is currently checked out to someone else, we can reserve that item for you and notify you when it is returned. You can also place a reserve or renew your items online at bonnechere.biblionix.com using your login (library card #) and password (last four digits of your phone number, that we have on record).
